MENTAL ABILITY

PAPER-I : MENTAL ABILITY (200Q/M).

Paper-3: Qualifying Paper English (Descriptive Type)

The candidate's understanding of the English language, its correct usage and their writing ability would be tested. Questions on short essay, comprehension, précis, letter writing, paragraph writing / report writing, translation from English to Telugu etc. would be included.

Paper-4: Qualifying Paper Telugu (Descriptive Type)

The candidates can choose to have one of the languages i.e., either Telugu or Urdu and should indicate their choice as and when asked for by the recruiting authority. Option once exercised will be final and a candidate will not be allowed to change it subsequently.

TELUGU: The candidate's understanding of the Telugu language, its correct usage and their writing ability would be tested. Questions on short essay, comprehension, précis, letter writing, paragraph writing / report writing, translation from Telugu to English etc. would be included.
